All students are now expected to attend school on Monday, April 21st.

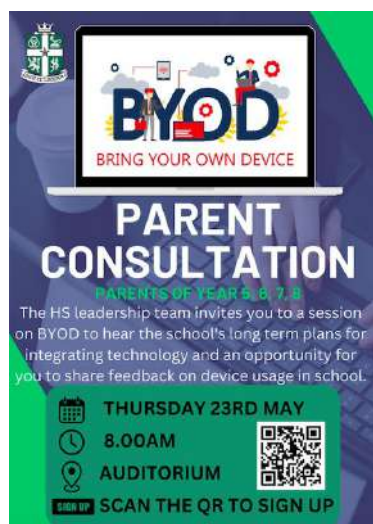

In the final day of football, the girls worked hard all day and scored some wonderful goals and the boys put in some excellent performances to finish 3rd and collect another trophy.

It was a fantastic week of sport for all involved and the students showed great character, determination and sportsmanship. We are very proud of all of the students who competed and how they represented the SJIIM community at this international event.

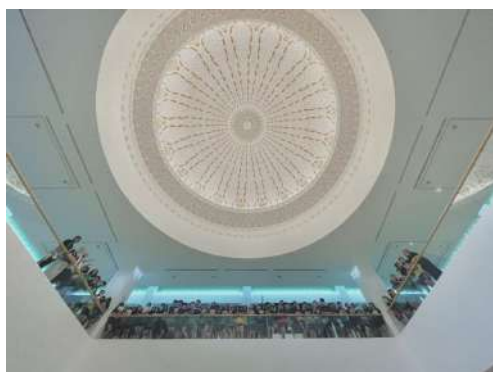
End of Year Examinations
