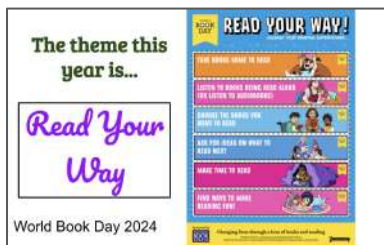
Hari Raya Celebrations

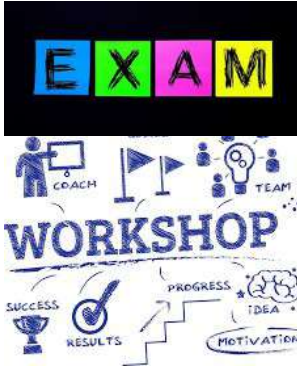
LEdu Service Projects Update

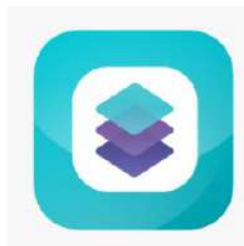
