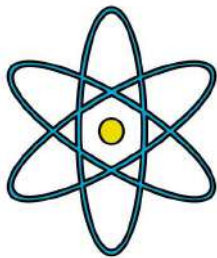




University and Careers Term3 Parent Workshop

Congratulations to the winners and highly commended students from the SJIM Science Fair 2024!



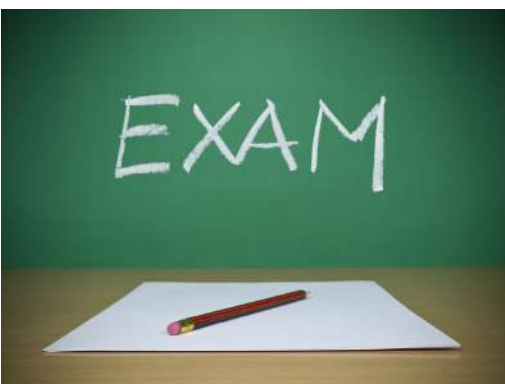
After-School Use of Sports Facilities
