The day started with a Mathematical Meltdown round, where students from all teams were mixed up and had to answer questions, find their teammates in different rooms and get back in the quickest time. This was a great way to start the day, with students from all schools mixing together. The remainder of the day had 4 competitive rounds: Dragon maths, Proof and Logic, Integration and graph sketching and finally, the Shuttle round. These were all team events with different formats, some involving running. Whilst it was a really challenging day of mathematics, our students demonstrated resilience and confidence when answering questions and their teamwork was a joy to witness. We are incredibly proud of all 24 students and their dedication to spending a Saturday doing yet more maths and would like to add an extra congratulations to 2 of our teams who secured third places in the Proof and Logic round. Well done to all!









# **High School TeachMeet**

Today saw the second of our three annual TeachMeets in High School. It was not only a great way for our talented staff to share best practice, research-based classroom strategies and innovative teaching & learning, but it is also instrumental in building a collegiate and sharing culture within our teaching community.

Our approach ensures that every teacher not only understands their strengths, areas of interest and areas for development, but they are encouraged to explore what's right for them, rather than a one-size-fits-all approach.

The topics for today's TeachMeets included evidence-based presentations on marking using comparative judgement, the impact of autonomy in the classroom, the use of tech and AI to reduce workload, project-based transdisciplinary learning and teaching Maths through storytelling (to name just a few!)
